- More than \$400,000 awarded to 55 regional WA community organisations.

The Community Partnerships Program provides funding of up to \$50,000 to successful organisations and events. Key evaluation criteria ensure successful applications are strategically aligned, deliver benefits in the Horizon Power service area, demonstrate clear community outcomes, and have a positive impact on a large portion of the community.
